### COVID-19 MEASURES

Airco has operating procedures in place to help protect the health of our passengers and our flight crew. All active staff are aware the complexities of working in the current environment, necessary precautions they must follow, and the importance of removing themselves from duty if they have health concerns. Aircraft and lobby are cleaned on a regular basis. In addition to this there are other mandatory measures in place. Please see below.

#### 1. FEDERAL VACCINE MANDATE

**Transport Canada's Interim Order requires individuals confirm their vaccination status before boarding at a designated airport. Proof of vaccination or proof of a valid medical or religious exemption must be carried by passengers at all times.**

To comply with the **FEDERAL VACCINE MANDATE** an individual must be either fully vaccinated (2 weeks after second vaccination) or have proof of a pre-approved medical or religious exemption. The Vaccine Mandate is not applicable to passengers under the age of 12 years 4 months

All passenger must sign a form stating they are vaccinated and do not have any Covid-19 symptoms. Information on the form may be shared with Transport Canada for aviation safety purposes. Providing a false or misleading answer to any questions on the form is a serious offence and you could liable to a monetary penalty.

#### 2. SOCIAL DISTANCING AND FACE MASKS

Air operator staff and travellers should try to maintain a minimum distance of 2 m between each other at all times. All passengers must be in possession of a face covering/mask prior to boarding the aircraft. Face masks should not be placed on children less than 2 years old; Children 2 years to less than 6 years old are encouraged to wear masks but it is not required if wearing a mask causes anxiety. Passengers must wear a face mask at all times during the flight except when eating, drinking or when the safety of the person could be endangered by wearing a face mask. Passengers must comply with flight crew members instructions with respect to wearing a face mask.

#### 3. HEALTH CHECK

Individuals are Prohibited from Boarding the Aircraft, as per an Interim Order issued by the Minister of Transport Canada, pursuant to sub-section 6.41(1) of the Aeronautics Act, if any of the following items apply:

- You have, or exhibit to have, **a fever and a cough or a fever and breathing difficulties**, unless you provide a medical certificate certifying your symptoms are not related to COVID-19
- **Have, or suspect you have, or are suspected of having, COVID-19**
- You have been denied permission to board an aircraft in the previous **14 days** for medical reasons related to COVID-19 or

- You are subject to a **mandatory quarantine order** (recent travel or local/provincial health order)

If any of the above conditions apply to you then you must self-quarantine. If you live in Alberta please contact Health Link by dialing 811 before visiting a medical facility. ### Vaccination Exemptions

Medical and Religious Exemption Forms for the vaccine mandate can be found on Transport Canada's website and on Airco's website. Forms must be completed and pre-approved by Airco prior to travel. Exemptions should be submitted for approval 20 days prior to travel.

Airco is not responsible for restrictions a traveller may be subject to at their destination at any time and especially when travelling out of province. It is very important you check on any provincial/territorial restrictions that could be in place with self-isolation plans. Provincial and Territorial information changes frequently.
